



General Conditions of Sale - Export Supplement

Exports:

(1) Unless the context otherwise requires, any term defined in the International Rules for the Interpretation of Trade Terms of the International Chamber of Commerce in force on the date of this Order ("Incoterms") will have the same meaning in this order, but if there is any conflict this Order will prevail

(2) The Customer will be responsible for complying with all legislation or regulations (including obtaining at its own cost all necessary licenses and authorities) governing the importation of the Goods into countries of destination outside the United Kingdom and for payment of all associated taxes and duties

(3) Delivery of the Goods or any installment will be subject to the granting of all necessary export licenses and the Customer will provide all necessary assistance and information to the Company to enable it to apply for or obtain them. The Company will not be liable for any loss, damage, liability or expense whatsoever arising from any delay in obtaining or failure to obtain any export licenses. Where Goods are ordered for export from the Customer's address in the United Kingdom or by the Customer's agent in the United Kingdom the Customer or its agent will be responsible for obtaining such licenses

(4) Unless otherwise agreed in writing between the Company and the Customer, the Goods will be delivered fob the air or sea port of shipment and the Company will be under no obligation to give notice under section 32(3) Sale of Goods Act 1979

This order is accepted subject to the above terms and the Company's General Conditions of Sale attached.
